GO WESTERN YOUNG MAN

The Hornets will close out a three game road trip when they are at Missouri Western on Jan. 28. ESU will be looking to break out of their first two game losing skid of the season. The last time ESU lost three straight on the road was during the 2006-07 season.

LAST TIME OUT

Emporia State outscored Northwest Missouri 56-42 from the 13:29 mark of the first half until the 6:06 mark of the second half, but were outscored 11-0 to start the game and 14-0 to end the game in a 67-56 loss in Maryville, Mo. on Saturday. Robert Moores led ESU with a game high 19 points and added four assists. Jeremiah Box and Alex Pyle each added 12 points for ESU.

THE COACHES

David Moe is 127-92 in his eighth season at ESU and is 118-73 since 2002. He has led ESU to appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2004 and 2007 and winning seasons in four of the last five years. He is the third winningest coach in ESU history behind Gus Fish and Ron Slaymaker. Moe is 8-8 in his career against MWSU.

Tom Smith is 393-211 in his 21st year at MWSU and 562-395 in 33 years overall. He is 31-10 during his career against ESU, with a 30-10 record while at Missouri Western.

SCOUTING THE GRIFFONS

Missouri Western is 8-10 overall and 5-6 in the MIAA. The Griffons are led by Lonnell Johnson who averages 14.4 points and Dominique Thurston who averages 14.8 points per game. The first time the two teams met this season Thurston had a double-double with 16 points and ten rebounds.

SERIES HISTORY

MWSU leads the overall series 38-24. ESU won the first meeting this season, however, and have won seven of the last ten meetings. The Hornets have won three of their last four meetings in MWSU Fieldhouse.

LAST TIME AGAINST MWSU

Emporia State outscored Missouri Western 51-25 in the first half and held on for an 88-77 win in White Auditorium. Lamar Wilbern had 19 points, five rebounds and five assists and Robert Moores had a game high 20 points for the Hornets. Jeremiah Box joined them in double figures with 15 points in the game.

UP NEXT

ESU starts a two-game homestand when Truman comes to Emporia on Feb. 1. Tip-off for the match-up is scheduled for 3:30 p.m. from W. L. White Auditorium in Emporia.

RUNNING WITH THE HORNETS

The Hornets are 36-10 since 2002-03 when reaching the 90 point plateau. The Hornets were third in the MIAA in scoring last season and led the MIAA in scoring in 2006 and 2007. ESU has led the MIAA in scoring in four of the last six seasons. ESU is averaging 87.5 points per game when playing at home this season.

AWAY FROM HOME

The Hornets opened the season with their first five games (two exhibition + three regular season) on the road and did not play at home for the first time until Nov. 25 when Ottawa came to White Auditorium. The Hornets are 4-4 so far this season when playing away from Emporia. Last season the Hornets opened with five straight at home, though they did take their longest road trip since joining the NCAA last season as they played six games spanning 32 days away from home. The Hornets have two, three games road trips in MIAA schedule.

A DAY AT HOME

The Hornets have had seven straight winning seasons in White Auditorium dating back to the 2002-03 season and including this season. The Hornets are 79-21 for a .790 winning percentage in White Auditorium over the last seven seasons. The Hornets have opened the season 9-1 and with a win over then #12 MSSU.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE

The Hornets currently rank second in the MIAA in three-point shooting percentage averaging .411 per game and are also second in three-pointers made per game averaging 8.7 on the year. ESU currently ranks fourth in the league in scoring margin.

ON THE DEFENSIVE

Emporia State is currently second in the MIAA in three-point percentage defense only allowing opponents .295 on the season. The Hornets rank fourth overall in rebounding margin. ESU also ranks third in the league in defensive rebounding. Lamar Wilbern ranks first in the MIAA in defensive rebounds averaging 6.7 per contest.

LAMAR, NEBRASKA

Guard Lamar Wilbern (Jr./Milwaukee, Wis.) had nine rebounds at NWMSU. He had 12 points and six rebounds against FHSU. He scored 18 points against WU. He had a career high 27 points and 16 rebounds against PSU. He had 17 against #12 MSSU. He had a game high 21 points against #3 SBU. He had a double-double with 22 points and ten rebounds against UNO. He had a double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds against TSU. He had a game high 20 points against Bethany. He recorded a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at UCM. He had 19 points and five assists against MWSU. He scored 14 points against then #21 NWMSU. He leads the Hornets with 15.6 points while he leads ESU at 7.9 boards per game. He leads the Hornets with 120 defensive rebounds this year 67 more than any other player. He had 22 points for the Hornets against Ottawa. He had his first career double-double against Newman scoring 18 points and pulling down 12 rebounds. He ranks first in the MIAA in defensive rebounds this season and is fourth in overall rebounding. He is currently seventh in scoring.

BOXING DAY

Forward Jeremiah Box (Jr./Rockford, Ill.) had 12 points against NWMSU. He had 12 points against FHSU. He scored 13 points against WU. He had 14 points against #12 MSSU. He had 14 points and eight rebounds against UNO. He had a game high 20 points against Central Christian. He had 15 points and a career high three blocks against MWSU. He scored 22 points against Ottawa. He is averaging 12.1 points per game. He had a career high 28 points at ENMU. He is currently eighth in the MIAA in three-pointers made while he is ranked tenth in the league in three point percentage at .400 on the year. He is 20th in the league in scoring.

He is averaging 6.1 points and 2.1 rebounds per game in nine starts. He had a career high eight rebounds against Newman.

NILES AND NILES OF REAL ESTATE

Guard Tim Niles (Jr./Brooklyn, N.Y.) led ESU with 14 points against FHSU. He went five of six from the line against WU. He had 16 points at PSU. He had a career high 16 points and eight rebounds against UNO. He was four of four from the charity stripe at TSU. He had 12 points against UCM. He had a career high 14 points against Central Christian. He had six points and four assists against MWSU. He had eight points and a career high three steals as ESU beat NWMSU. He had six points to go along with a career high six assists in the Hornets win over Benedictine. He is averaging 8.6 points per game this year. He had 13 points against Ottawa.

FULL HOUSE

Forward Adam Holthaus (So./Wichita, Kan.) scored in double figures for the third straight game with 13 points against FHSU. He scored 10 points in the win over Washburn.
