The Hornets continue their long road trip with a game at Northwest Missouri on Oct. 10. They are in the midst traveling to ten of their first 12 for the first time in school history as the six game road trip to open the season was also the longest in school history.

THE COACHES

Jim Schneiderhahn is 8-57-3 in his fourth year at ESU and 47-101-9 in his ninth year as a head coach. He came to ESU after serving as an assistant coach at Tulane University. He was the head coach at Benedictine from 2000-04. He holds a United State Soccer Federation (USSF) National "A" Coaching License.

Tracy Hoza is 45-66-3 in her seventh season with the Bearcats.

LAST TIME-OUT

The Emporia State soccer team was outshot 22-5 as they fell 5-0 to Nebraska-Omaha on the road. ESU got four shots on goal in the match as Nikki Schmitz finished with six saves. Amanda Miano had two shots on goal for the Hornets as was joined by Jessica Decker and Sarah Anderson who added one each.

SCOUTING REPORT

Northwest Missouri State enters the match 8-3-1 on the season and 4-3-1 in the MIAA. They are led by Andrea Tritz who has scored four goals with one assists on the season and Kelsey Sanders who has three goals and three assists on the season. Heidi Sobota has two goals on the season to go along with four assists. Between the pipes they feature Kira Lazenby who has a 0.72 goals against average with 64 saves on the year and has added one assist for the Bearcats.

LAST TIME AGAINST UNO

After giving up a goal off a corner kick two minutes into the match, Emporia State played Northwest Missouri even for 88 minutes in a 1-0 loss in Maryville, Mo. on Thursday. Alicia Smith had a team high four shots, with both of her shots on goal coming in the second period

ESU will travel up the turnpike for the first edition of the Turnpike Tussle this season as they take on Washburn on Oct. 15 in Topeka, Kan. They then return home Sunday, Oct. 18 to face UNO.

2009 EMPORIA STATE SOCCER GAME NOTES

A NEW PLACE TO PLAY

The Hornets will play all their scheduled home games on campus for the first time in school history. They played four games last season at ESU Pitch getting their first on campus win with a 1-0 shutout of Missouri Western on September 18, 2008. ESU Pitch is located just north of the student recreation center on the campus of Emporia State University.

AGENT SCHMITZ

Nikki Schmitz (Fr. • San Antonio, Texas) has made six starts in goal for the Hornets this season with seven total appearances. She is 1-6 on the season with one shut-out and 52 saves. She has allowed 18 goals on the season for a 2.54 goals against average. She currently is first in the MIAA in saves per match, she ranks sixth in save percentage and ninth in goals against average.

WE GOSCHA!

Katrina Goscha (Jr. • Bucyrus, Kan.) has made three starts in goal for the Hornets and is 0-2-1 on the season. She has 10 saves and has allowed eight goals for a 2.77 goals against average.

PROPANE AND PROPANE ACCESSORIES

Ashley Hill (Fr. • Olathe, Kan.) has three goals this season for the Hornets including one game winner. She has 11 shots, six of which have been on goal. She scored her first career goal at the 45:37 mark of the match with East Central to tie the score at one.

ROCKY HORROR PICTURE SHOW

Raquel White (Sr. • Victorville, Calif.) got her first goal of the season to give ESU the lead against East Central on their way to a 2-2 tie. She has seven shots on the season three of which have been on goal.

THE ANDERSON BUILDING

Sarah Anderson (So. • Overland Park, Kan.) added her second goal in as many games against Missouri Southern. She leads the Hornets in assists with two on the season and to her first goal against Central Missouri. She ranks eighth in the MIAA in assists per match. She also leads the team in shots with 23 and shots on goal with 12 this year.

RALPH LAUREN

Lauren Cathey (Jr. • Ft. Collins, Colo.) got her first assist against Central Missouri. She has made the start in 44 out of 48 matches in her career. Has three shots on the season two of which have been on goal.

DEFENSE!!! DEFENSE!!!

ESU returns All-MIAA selection **Jessica Decker** who anchors a defense that features three returning starters and one newcomer. Returning starters **Kylee McCullough** and **Tessa Pettyjohn** have both made atleast eight starts for the Hornets this season. Newcomer **Sarah Whiteside** joined the defense and has started six straight games after coming back from an early season injury.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The Hornets have ten underclassmen on the roster this season with only three seniors. Only five players on the roster coming into the season had more than one year of experience playing at ESU. Three true freshman have made starts for ESU this year.
