THE LONG ROAD

The Hornets will play their eighth match away from home this season when they travel to Nebraska-Omaha. The Hornets opened the 2009 season with six straight on the road and play 10 of their first 12 away from ESU Pitch.

THE COACHES

Jim Schneiderhahn is 8-56-3 in his fourth year at ESU and 47-100-9 in his ninth year as a head coach. He came to ESU after serving as an assistant coach at Tulane University. He was the head coach at Benedictine from 2000-04. He holds a United State Soccer Federation (USSF) National "A" Coaching License.

Dan Closterman is 177-43-7 in his tenth season with the Mavericks.

LAST TIME-OUT

The Emporia State soccer team fell 2-1 at Missouri Southern on Thursday. ESU was outshot 24-15 on the evening, but only 9-8 in shots on goal. Sarah Anderson had her second goal in as many matches as Holli Schletbaum added her first assist of the year. Anderson finished with five shtos, three of which were on goal and Jessica Decker finished with four shots.

SCOUTING REPORT

Nebraska-Omaha enters the match 7-4 on the season and 6-1 in the MIAA. They are led by Nicole Baier who has scored seven goals and added six assists good for 20 points on the season and also has a hat trick. Jessica Powers has added six goals and two asissts good for 14 points on the year. Between the pipes they feature Lauren Fox who is 5-1 on the season she has only allowed 10 goals good for a 1.22 goals against averaging and has 36 saves.

LAST TIME AGAINST UNO

The ESU soccer team fell 3-0 on the road in Omaha on Saturday. The Hornets were outshot 24-5, but got three shots on goal. Two of the Hornet shots on goal came from Amanda Miano had two of the Hornet shots on goal while Alicia Smith added the other. Jennifer Stillmock had 11 saves in the match for the Hornets.

UP NEXT

ESU will travel to Northwest Missouri for a 12 noon kick-off on Oct. 10 and then will go to Washburn for a 7 p.m. kick on Oct. 15. They will then return home for six of their last seven at ESU Pitch.

A NEW PLACE TO PLAY

The Hornets will play all their scheduled home games on campus for the first time in school history. They played four games last season at ESU Pitch getting their first on campus win with a 1-0 shutout of Missouri Western on September 18, 2008. ESU Pitch is located just north of the student recreation center on the campus of Emporia State University.

AGENT SCHMITZ

Nikki Schmitz (Fr. • San Antonio, Texas) has made five starts in goal for the Hornets this season with seven total appearances. She is 1-5 on the season with one shut-out and 46 saves. She has allowed 13 goals on the season for a 2.05 goals against average. She currently is currently first in the MIAA in saves per match, she ranks sixth in save percentage and ninth in goals against average.

WE GOSCHA!

Katrina Goscha (Jr. • Bucyrus, Kan.) has made three starts in goal for the Hornets and is 0-2-1 on the season. She has 10 saves and has allowed eight goals for a 2.77 goals against average.

PROPANE AND PROPANE ACCESSORIES

Ashley Hill (Fr. • Olathe, Kan.) has three goals this season for the Hornets including one game winner. She has 11 shots, six of which have been on goal. She scored her first career goal at the 45:37 mark of the match with East Central to tie the score at one.

ROCKY HORROR PICTURE SHOW

Raquel White (Sr. • Victorville, Calif.) got her first goal of the season to give ESU the lead against East Central on their way to a 2-2 tie. She has seven shots on the season three of which have been on goal.

THE ANDERSON BUILDING

Sarah Anderson (So. • Overland Park, Kan.) added her second goal in as many games against Missouri Southern. She leads the Hornets in assists with two on the season and to her first goal against Central Missouri. She ranks eighth in the MIAA in assists per match. She also leads the team in shots with 16 and shots on goal with eight.

RALPH LAUREN

Lauren Cathey (Jr. • Ft. Collins, Colo.) got her first assist against Central Missouri. She has made the start in 44 out of 48 matches in her career. Has three shots on the season two of which have been on goal.

DEFENSE!!! DEFENSE!!!

ESU returns All-MIAA selection **Jessica Decker** who anchors a defense that features three returning starters and one newcomer. Returning starters **Kylee McCullough** and **Tessa Pettyjohn** have both made atleast eight starts for the Hornets this season. Newcomer **Sarah Whiteside** joined the defense and has started six straight games after coming back from an early season injury.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The Hornets have ten underclassmen on the roster this season with only three seniors. Only five players on the roster coming into the season had more than one year of experience playing at ESU. Three true freshman have made starts for ESU this year.
