### SENIOR DAY

Emporia State will wrap-up the regular season with a Senior Day doubleheader against Ft. Hays State. Megan Dennis, Jill Peters, Aubree Brattin, Jennifer Dace and Shelbe Hughes will be recognized between games. The Preston Family Scoreboard will also be dedicated prior to the game.

### LAST AT BAT

Emporia State pitchers combined to hold Washburn to just six hits and one run in a double header sweep. The Hornets won the first game 4-1 and took the second game 8-0. Megan Dennis struck out five of the first six batters she faced and retired the first 14 before giving up a two out walk in the fifth. She took a no hitter into the seventh before giving up a run on three hits. Jennifer Heerey tossed her fifth shutout of the year in the night cap, scattering three hits and walking two with five strike outs.

### THE COACHES

Kristi Bredbenner is 194-49 in her fourth year at Emporia State and 225-68 in five years as a head coach. She has been named MIAA Coach of the Year the last two years and her staff was named the 2006 and 2008 NFCA Regional Coaching Staff of the Year. She has led the Hornets to two national championship games and the regional championship game in every season as head coach. She's led the Hornets to three MIAA titles as head coach and three straight conference tournament crowns. She is 6-2 against FHSU while at ESU.

Juliea LeMaire is 28-26 in her first year at FHSU.

### SCOUTING THE TIGERS

Ft. Hays State is 29-26 overall and 5-9 in the MIAA. Hallie McMillen is batting .357 with three home runs and 36 RBI. As a team the Tigers have 20 triples on the year. Kayla Rupa is 16-15 with a 2.91 ERA and Adrian Mohr is 12-9 with a 4.03 ERA. Both have started 26 games in the circle for FHSU.

### SERIES RECORD

The Hornets lead the all-time series 28-16. FHSU has given ESU some trouble over the last few years. The Tigers handed the Hornets one of their three MIAA losses last season and also picked up a win during ESU's 62-7 season in 2006.

### LAST TIME AGAINST WU

The #12 Hornet softball team opened the 2008 MIAA Softball Tournament with a 11-0 win over Fort Hays State. The Hornets hit four long balls in the game and seven of their 14 hits were for extra bases as they out hit the Tigers 14-2 in the game. Jennifer Dace started the fireworks with solo home run in the second inning. April Huddleston added a solo shot of her own in the third inning. In the Hornets six run fourth inning Abby Smith and Miranda Campbell each added two run homers. The Hornet offense scored at least one run in every frame putting up three runs in the first and six runs in the fourth. In the circle Samantha Sheeley earned her 21st win of the season as she combined with Megan Dennis to throw a two hitter.

The Hornets will open defense of their MIAA Tournament title on Thursday, April 30 at 6 p.m. ESU's doubleheader at Newman has been canceled.

## HORNET HISTORY

Emporia State has finished as the NCAA Division II National Runners-up twice in the last three years. ESU has qualified for NCAA Regional play five straight years and six times in the last 13 seasons. **The Hornets won the NAIA National Championship in 1983 and 1984 and won the AIAW National Championship in 1980.** ESU has won five straight MIAA post-season tourney titles and had won four straight MIAA regular season championships.

## APPLES TO ORANGES

The Hornets are 34-13 with two games left in the regular season and are ranked ninth in the South Central Region. Last year ESU was 36-15 in the regular season and were the top ranked team in the North Central Region. Last year the Hornets' team batting average was .309 in the regular season and they had 43 home runs and 80 doubles entering the MIAA tournament. This year ESU is hitting .319 as a team and has 42 homers and 76 doubles in four fewer games. In the circle the Hornets had a 2.45 team ERA in regular season play last year while they have a 2.50 ERA this season. The biggest difference has been in strike outs. Last year ESU pitchers struck out their opponents 369 times in the regular season while this season the Hornet pitching staff has 244 strike outs.

## HOME COOKING

The Hornets have won 22 of their last 25 games at the Trusler Sports Complex. ESU has won 41 of their last 44 MIAA games in the Trusler Sports Complex. As a team the Hornets are hitting .340 at home.

## TIMELY HITTING

Nearly half (109 of 231) of ESU's RBI this season have come with two outs. Seven players have at least ten two-out RBI and every Hornet with at least five two-out at bats has at least three two-out RBI. As a team ESU is hitting .325 with two outs, led by Abby Hughes .432 average.

## M-M GOOD

Third baseman **Miranda Campbell** (Jr./Bogota, Texas) leads the MIAA in on base percentage and walks and is second in batting average. She ranks 14th in the nation in walks, 18th in sacrifice flies and 30th in on-base percentage. She is fourth in the league in stolen bases and fifth in runs scored, seventh in hits and slugging percentage and tenth in RBI. She hit two home runs and was three for four with three walks against Missouri Western. She earned second-team All-American honors from both the NFCA and CoSIDA last season. She was named the Most Outstanding Player at the North Central Regional and to the All-Tournament team at the World Series. She was the MIAA Player of the Week after the conference tournament when she batted .615 with a home run and eight RBI. She was a first-team All-MIAA performer and earned All-Region honors from the NFCA and CoSIDA. A 3.59 student in health promotions, she was also named an ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District performer.

## MAHAN IN THE FIELD

Second baseman **Angela Mahan** (So./Liberty, Mo.) is ninth in the MIAA in batting, ranks third in doubles and runs scored, eighth in hits, and tenth in on base percentage. She is batting .361 with a team high 43 runs scored and 17 doubles. She is tied for fifth in single season doubles at ESU and will move into a five way tie for the record with her next two bagger. She was five for seven with three runs in the double header at PSU including the game winning run in the night cap. She was three for four with four runs scored and three RBI in the nightcap against Truman. She has started 106 of the 107 games she has played at ESU over the last two years.

## DACE TO THE FINISH

First baseman **Jennifer Dace** (Jr./Olathe, Kan.) is ranked fourth in the MIAA in doubles and sixth in RBI. She is hitting .310 on the year with 36 RBI and 15 doubles. She is two doubles away from tying the ESU career record. She is on a seven game hitting streak and leads ESU with 11 multiple RBI games. She was three for three with two doubles in the Hornets' 5-4 win at MSSU. She had two homers in ESU's 5-4 win over NWMSU. She has 15 two out RBI this season. She earned All-Tournament honors at the North Central Regional. She led ESU in RBI during the regular season on her way to First-Team All-Region honors and Second-Team All-MIAA accolades. She has started all 239 games in her career at ESU.

## BRATTIN DOWN THE HATCHES

Catcher **Aubree Brattin** (Jr./Greenwood, Mo.) has started every game for ESU behind the plate since arriving on campus. She has thrown out ten of 24 base runners and has picked off seven this season. She is batting .316 on the year with 27 runs scored and 28 RBI. She was two for three with two doubles and four RBI in the first game against Truman. She earned honorable mention All-MIAA honors and was named to the All-Tournament team at the North Central Regional and the World Series.

## COMING UP HUGHES

Shortstop **Abby Hughes** (So./Olathe, Kan.) is the only player in the MIAA to be ranked in the top ten of both home runs and stolen bases. She is fifth in the MIAA in home runs, sixth in stolen bases, seventh in RBI, eighth in runs and ninth in slugging percentage. She ranks seventh in the nation in sacrifice hits per game. She is batting .333 with ten home runs, 34 RBI and 16 stolen bases. She has a team best 17 two out RBI on the season. She transferred to ESU from Nebraska where she played in 35 games with eight starts as a freshman.

## ORDER OF THE PHOENIX

Center fielder **Jenna Potter** (Jr./Emporia, Kan.) is batting .248 with five home runs and seven doubles on the year. Her two out RBI pulled ESU within a run of MWSU on Tuesday. Her diving catch preserved Megan Dennis' perfect game against Newman. She hit two home runs in the double header with Truman. She was an honorable mention All-MIAA performer as a sophomore. She began her ESU career as a pitcher but has transitioned to centerfield.

## GETTING KETTER

Left fielder **Linda Ketter** (Jr./Home, Kan.) is hitting .333 with 29 runs scored and 15 RBI. She has had three hitting streaks of at least six games and her nine game hitting streak to open the season is the second longest by a Hornet this year. She hit a home run every 10.25 at bats through her first two years at ESU.

## SMITH AND WESSON

Right fielder **Abby Smith** (So./Liberty, Mo.) is hitting .321 with 22 RBI and is on a season high seven game hitting streak. She was second-team All-MIAA at designated player last season.

## WAY TO JACK IT, JILL

Designated player **Jill Peters** (Sr./Wichita, Kan.) is ranked fifth in the MIAA in walks per game. She is batting .245 with five home runs on the season. Her grand slam home run was the game winner against Tarleton State. She has an on base percentage of .458 when leading of an inning this season.

## DENNIS THE MENACE

Pitcher **Megan Dennis** (Sr./Liberty, Mo.) tossed a perfect game against Newman. She is fifth in the MIAA in strikeouts per 7.0 innings and wins, ninth in ERA and tenth in opponent batting average. She leads the MIAA with three saves, but is also third in complete games. She had a perfect game through 4.2 innings and took a no hitter into the seventh against Washburn. She threw her fifth shut out of the year against MWSU. She did not allow an earned run against UCM. She tossed a three hit shut out in game two at PSU after throwing the final 4.2 innings of the first game. She is 16th in the nation in saves. She picked up the win in the Hornets 2-1 victory over St. Edwards in the World Series. She was an honorable mention All-MIAA performer last season.

## HEAR YE, HEAR YE!

Pitcher **Jennifer Heerey** (Fr./Wichita, Kan.) is second in the MIAA in wins and ranks seventh in ERA. She is ninth in strikeouts per 7.0 innings and opponents batting average. She tossed a three hit shut out at Washburn, her fifth shut out of the season. She had a three hit shut out of UCM. She threw back to back shut outs of Rockhurst and Incarnate Word. She is the only freshman among the MIAA top nine in wins and her 18 wins are the most by a Hornet freshman since Melissa Stevens went 20-5 in 2003.

## AS A TEAM IN THE MIAA STATS

The Hornets are leading the MIAA in team batting average at .319 while not other team is hitting above .290 this season. ESU is leading the conference in slugging percentage at .484, with Washburn's .452 in second.

## ESU IN THE NATIONAL STATS

As a team the Hornets are ranked 23rd in the nation in double plays per game, 32nd in doubles per game and stolen bases per game, 35th in slugging percentage, 37th in batting average and home runs per game, 62nd in scoring and 78th in ERA. Individually Miranda Campbell is ranked 14th in walks, 18th in sacrifice flies and 30th in on-base percentage, Abby Hughes is seventh in sacrifice hits and Megan Dennis is 16th in saves.
