To be considered for a Department of Biological Sciences scholarship, new students must meet the guidelines of the Biological Sciences Scholars Award Program: (1) an ACT \geq 24 (or equivalent); (2) a GPA \geq 3.5 on a 4-point scale (unless lower GPA allowed for specific scholarship); and (3) a high school course background that is consistent with the intended major. Applicants must include a cover letter detailing their motivation for pursuing biology and applying for the scholarship.

Complete both sides of this application and return it by **FEBRUARY 12th, 2009.**

Scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time during the period for which they receive a scholarship (minimum of 12 credit hours). Biological Sciences Academic Scholarship Applications will be reviewed between February 12th and late April by a scholarship committee. Students will be notified by letter from the Biological Sciences following a review of applications.

Activity scholarships (e.g., music, debate, drama, art) are awarded by the respective departments. **Athletic scholarships** are awarded by the team coaches. Please check with the appropriate departments or coaches for priority dates and requirements.
