Emporia State University will host a Fulbright Faculty Scholar Workshop on **Tuesday, April 3rd, from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. in the Roe R. Cross Room, CH 204.**

The workshop will be conducted by Gary Garrison, Assistant Director, Fulbright Scholar Program, Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES).

Attendees will: learn about lecturing and research opportunities in 150 countries; get advice on which country to apply to and how to make contacts abroad; learn how to prepare the Fulbright application; and, explore how your campus can host visiting foreign Fulbright scholars.

Receive compensation for grant proposal development

The Research & Grants Center is offering opportunities for faculty members to receive compensation for developing and writing grant proposals. The faculty members chosen to participate may request reassigned time for one course or summer compensation equal to reassigned time for one course, depending upon arrangements made with the department chair. The faculty member must be committed to developing and writing an external grant proposal which should be submitted within one year of receiving compensation. The Research & Grants Center will offer financial support for the reassigned time or summer compensation and assistance on the grant proposal.

Faculty members do not need to have previous proposal writing experience, although it may be helpful. Interested faculty members should submit a one-page summary of their proposal idea to the Research and Grants Center by **March 1, 2007**. Department chairs may also recommend faculty members for this opportunity. Please contact Pam Fillmore if you have any questions.

Reminder – Deadline is March 12 for nominations for President's Award

Nominations for the 2007 President's Award for Research & Creativity must be submitted to the Research and Grants Center by 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, March 12**. This award is intended to honor an ESU individual who has been active in research, scholarly activity, or creative endeavors. The award includes \$1,000, which the recipient can choose to receive as a stipend or for professional travel, and the recipient will be the keynote speaker at the Research & Creativity Forum on April 12.
