Instant Messaging

Free Printing Services

- Individual jobs 25 pages or fewer are free
- Individual jobs over 25 pages will be charged 10 cents per page over the 25 pages per individual job

All print jobs are sent to the Reference/Information Desk, 2nd floor. The deadline for picking up print jobs is 15 minutes before the library closes for the day or evening.

All print jobs default to a duplex printer (printing on both sides) to save paper and toner.

****If you need a print job to be printed on one side only, you can change the default printer to "noduplex".

What can You Do For William Allen White Library?

Follow Food and Drink Policy

Food and drink pose a potential risk to library collections, equipment, and furnishings. We ask that you act responsibly when consuming food and drink in White Library and practice a **"Leave No Trace"** policy:

Policy Highlights

- Plan ahead and prepare. Be aware of the White Library food and drink policy
- Dispose of waste properly, using the trash and recycling containers provided throughout the library
- Leave library collections, equipment, and furnishings as you found them, or in better condition
- Respect and be considerate of other library patrons
- If there is a spill of food or drink, please contact White Library personnel immediately so that the spill can be cleaned up as quickly as possible.

Food items and drinks in covered containers are allowed in most areas:

- Study tables
- Booths
- Chairs and couches

Drinks in covered containers are allowed:

- In the Library Electronic Classroom, 2nd floor
- Near public access computers and media equipment, 2nd floor
- Near laptop computers owned by White Library
- On the 4th floor of White Library

The consumption of food and drink items in White Library **is not allowed** in the following designated areas:

- Near photocopiers, printers, and microform readers/printers
- Areas where books and other library materials are shelved
- University Archives areas of White Library

The delivery of food to White Library for patrons is not permitted.

Be Aware of Information Security Incidents

An Information Security Incident (IS) is something that has happened to compromise the information of students, faculty and staff as well as ESU business information. An IS incident could be:

- A) Your ESU owned computer or laptop is missing
- B) Your ESU network account is being used when you were not using it
- C) Someone else's User ID is showing on the logon screen
- D) You notice unsafe information protection practices happening

When IS incidents happen, serious threats and consequences can occur. ESU faculty, and staff are responsible for reporting suspected or known security incidents, including any observed or suspected security weakness in ESU systems or services. 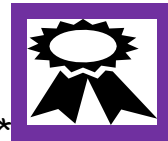
