## Scholarships and Financial Aid

AustraLearn assists over 70% of all participants each semester with some form of financial aid or scholarships. U.S. Federal Financial

Aid is available to both study abroad and full degree students. Scholarships (over \$150,000 USD) are given by AustraLearn to study abroad participants each year.

## Our South Pacific Educational Support Center

AustraLearn's on-site Resident Director team in both Australia and New Zealand help students with any problems they encounter during their time abroad. We help with housing, academics and emergencies, as well as excursions and holiday travel.

## Eligibility

We work with students from all backgrounds (including those with special needs), all academic majors and students from any 2 or 4-year institution in the United States or Canada. All students must complete a set of application materials including academic references, home university approval and transcript review. Undergraduate study abroad students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0.
