Complete this application only if you will be a declared major in the Physical Sciences. To be considered for Departments of Physical Sciences scholarships, new students must meet the guidelines of the *Physical Sciences Scholars Award Program*. Briefly, they are the following: (1) an ACT \geq 24; (2) a GPA \geq 3.5 (a complete application will require a transcript of work to date); (3) a high school course background that is “consistent” with the intended major; and (4) consultation with a Physical Sciences faculty member (generally through a campus visit).

Complete both sides of this application and return it by **FEBRUARY 15** prior to a fall semester of intended enrollment (see instructions for returning).

Scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time during the period for which they receive a scholarship (minimum of 12 credit hours). Physical Sciences Academic Scholarship Applications will be reviewed between the **February deadline date and early April**. Students will be notified of awards by letter from the Physical Sciences following review of applications.

Activity scholarships (i.e., music, debate, drama, art) are awarded by the respective ESU departments. **Athletic scholarships** are awarded by the team coaches. Please check with the appropriate departments or coaches for priority dates and requirements.
