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Travel assistance offered for FY 2006

The R&G Center will continue to offer travel assistance for faculty presenting papers at out-of-state professional meetings or for other eligible activities (see #1 below). Requests for assistance should be submitted on the appropriate application form **at least 30 days before the trip begins**. The application form is available at O:\COMMON\Grants\ travel.doc, www.emporia.edu/research/travel.pdf, as well as on Informs as ogsrtrav. Requests should be sent to the R&G Center, Box 4003. Questions regarding this program should be directed to Pam Fillmore, ext. 5351.

Guidelines:

- Partial travel support is provided for ESU faculty to present papers on research or scholarly activities at out-of-state meetings. Eligible activities may also include poster presentations, performances, chairing panel discussions, or invitations to present creative work.
- A maximum of \$300 for domestic travel or \$600 for international travel, per fiscal year.
- Partial support must also be provided by the school, college, or department, *but such support does not have to be an exact match.*
- Faculty may receive partial support for more than one trip, up to the maximum of \$300 for domestic travel or \$600 for international travel per fiscal year.
- Applications should be submitted at least 30 days before the trip begins.

Research assistance available

The Research and Grants Center has a graduate research assistant available during the academic year to assist faculty who do not have access to a research assistant and who need help with certain aspects of a research project. This position is funded by the Faculty Research and Creativity Committee.

She has a strong interest in research and will provide assistance with literature searches, funding opportunity searches, and various other aspects of research. Financial Assistance for Scholarly Exhibition and Page Charges

The R&G Center will provide financial assistance for scholarly exhibition and page charges for faculty who's scholarly and creative achievements require this type of funding. Requests for assistance should be submitted **at least 30 days prior to any journal or exhibition deadlines**. The application form is available at O:\Common\Grants\pageapp.doc, or at www.emporia.edu/research/pagecharges.htm. Requests should be sent to the Research and Grants Center, Box 4003. Questions regarding this program should be directed to Pam Fillmore, ext. 5351.

Guidelines:

- Partial support is provided for ESU faculty for purposes of exhibiting creative works, performances, and for publication of scholarly work requiring page charges.
- One-third of total costs can be awarded, up to a maximum of \$500 per fiscal year.
- The award must be matched by the school, college, or department.
- Only original research, compositions, arrangements, productions or pieces qualify for this assistance. Repeat exhibitions, performances, or publications will not be considered.
- The request for assistance is due at least 30 days prior to any journal or exhibition deadlines.
