## PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

It shall be the policy of Emporia State University to allow floats in the parade subject to the following stipulations:

- Registration forms must be turned in by the registration deadline, October 16, 2009.
- One entry per business/RSO please.
- All entries must relate to the Haunted Homecoming theme.
- Participants who want their entry to be judged for a prize must have their float assembled and in line in their designated location by **9:30 a.m.**
- City of Emporia Parade Policy strictly prohibits candy, prizes, novelty items or any other items being thrown, deposited or otherwise distributed from any unit or individual participant of a parade event.
- Floats, vehicles, and/or any other units of the parade must be safe in both vehicular mobility and in any attachments placed upon them. Persons riding such floats, vehicles, or other units must be in positions where they cannot be accidently thrown or dislodged.
- All Parade participants must comply with current traffic laws and regulation. For everyone's safety, we ask all motorized vehicles to refrain from excessive acceleration, wheelies, burnouts, etc. The Parade is for the community's enjoyment—please be considerate.
- City of Emporia Parade guidelines require entries with livestock (horses, dogs, etc.) to provide their own street cleanup behind the entry.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or consumption of alcohol is permitted in the ceremony or Parade. Any participant judged to be in possession of or under the influence of alcohol, or any other substance, shall be asked to leave and subject to removal if not done.

## PARADE ROUTE

- All entries will be lined up beginning at 4th and Commercial. Entries will travel north on Commercial St. and end at 12th and Commercial.
- ESU affiliated organizations and departments are invited to continue through Kellogg Circle, north on the Pedestrian Mall, onto Morse Road and will conclude at the Black Hole in Gray Parking.
