A minor in theatre may be taken by students who have majors in other disciplines. The minor consists of 18 hours in specified theatre courses. Courses in theatre are excellent supplements for students planning careers in education, music, business, psychology, counseling, public relations, communication, law, the ministry and other fields which require the ability to work exceptionally well with other people. It is also an appropriate choice for students whose program requires a minor as well as for students who are required to have a second program of study for the BA degree.
