1. The GEAT reviewed the Minutes – Points from discussion
2. Next Steps – Planning
 - Design a survey that will be administered to all faculty teaching 100-499 numbered courses.
 - We are wanting to identify the extent that “personal” and “social” well-being are currently being integrated in the courses.
 - We are seeking clarification of the understanding of the term well-being and to identify the variety of contexts that the term is being allied in.
 - We are seeking to gain insights about how the faculty define well-being and to determine if the term “well-being” is currently appropriate for the intended student learning experiences.
 - Upon conclusion of the survey and analyzing the results the GEAT will look to rewrite the goal for clarity of purpose to include appropriate terminology and measureable learning objectives.
 - Based on the survey findings a determination will be made to employ focus groups to gain greater insights and breadth/depth of understanding how Goal 4 is integrated into the curriculum.
 - Possibly identify additional courses to add the general education curriculum.
 - Confirm that the goal topics are inclusive and look to add new topics/concepts related to well-being.
