 - a. Some of the Specifics for the Survey
 - i. The goal is to have the survey questions identified for each of the GE Goals 2 and 3 prior to the end of the fall term. This allows time for the survey to be built over the winter break (Jo and Rich) with time to edit at the beginning of the spring 2018 term.
 - ii. Each GEAT member is to write up questions to share at the next set of meetings (Oct. 20 and 25). Use the GEAT 1 survey for ideas, but don't feel like you have to do the same thing, it is ok for the survey to be directly applicable to goals 2 and 3.

- iii. We will continue to craft the surveys throughout the rest of the fall 2017 term.
- iv. The survey will launch the first week of February in spring 2018.
- v. The survey will include both goals with skip logic built in to allow for general education faculty to respond to either or both goals as it relates to their specific general education course(s). Faculty wanting to respond to the survey for more than one course will need to complete the survey for each separate course.
- vi. The survey will be sent to all faculty (not GTA) assigned to teach a general education course any time during Academic Year 2018 (Summer 17, Fall 17, Spring 18).
