<p>Logan Avenue Elementary School, Emporia, KS</p>	<p>Fall After School Book Club to provide additional instruction in literacy for students that need to improve their reading.</p> <p>Logan Avenue Elementary School has a young teaching staff, 8 of the 12 teachers are in their first five years of teaching. The focus of the PD will be literacy, interactive writing, classroom strategies for interactive learning, and Core Six.</p>	<p>Guided Reading levels for students attending the Afterschool Book Club.</p> <p>18 students attended the first and second sessions of the Book Club for a total of 19 nights. There were six 2<sup>nd</sup> graders, six 3<sup>rd</sup> graders, and six fourth graders. 13 of the 18 showed growth for an average of 1.72 guided reading levels.</p> <p>12 students in grades 2-5 attended the first session of the Book Club for a total of 13 nights. There were two 2<sup>nd</sup> graders, one 3<sup>rd</sup> grader, one 4<sup>th</sup> grader, and eight 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Ten of the twelve showed growth for an average of 1.42 guided reading levels.</p>
