

FSL Chapter Value Awards 2019

Presented at the Greek Banquet 2019, April 19th, 2019

This award process starts with each chapter completing all tasks associated with being a recognized fraternity/sorority in the Officer of Fraternity and Sorority Life at Emporia State University. Those requirements can be found in the OFSL Policy and Procedure Manual.

Each chapter seeking recognition must also complete an online application and answer several short answer questions about how the chapter exhibits or works towards excellence in each core value. Chapters must complete both steps of the process to be considered.

Winners of each award are determined by a judges' score and the evidence provided in the Standards of Fraternal Excellence annual accreditation packet. One fraternity and one sorority will be selected as a winner for each award except for the Brotherhood/Sisterhood of the Year awards.

2019 eligible chapters: Alpha Kappa Lambda, Chi Omega, Sigma Pi, and Sigma Sigma Sigma.
