Student Accessibility & Support Services (SASS) has funds, received from generous donors and organizations, for ESU students with disabilities that have registered with SASS. Six scholarships are available.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Registered with SASS as a student with a documented disability.
- Meet the eligibility criteria of the scholarship for which you are applying.
- Submit a completed scholarship application form, unofficial ESU transcript, and essay. (Essay requirements are listed on the attached application.)
- Submit all information to the SASS by noon, Friday, February 28, 2020.
Applications submitted after the due date will not be considered

The SASS Scholarship Committee will review the applications during the spring 2020 semester and award scholarships for 2020-2021 academic year. Awards will be equally disbursed fall and spring semesters. In the event a student receives a scholarship, but does not attend ESU during the 2020-2021 academic year, the scholarship will go to another student.

<input type="checkbox"/> Emporia Beta Sigma Phi Scholarship	Must be visually impaired, hearing impaired or have a visible disability.
<input type="checkbox"/> Emporia Breakfast Club Scholarship	Any disability qualifies. Must have a financial need and preference is for a student visually impaired.
<input type="checkbox"/> Humphreys Scholarship	Must have a physical disability. Preference will go to students with financial need.
