### **NOTABLE TEACHING/PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES**

#### **Respecialization Program Creation**

In 2002, I created what may be the country's first school psychologist respecialization program, there being no other references to such programs prior to 2004. As of 2017, creation of such programs became the #1 strategic priority of the National Association of School Psychologists, to address trainer shortages. The program I created allows a working professional with an M.S. in a related field to attain an Ed.S. and licensure in as short as 18 months. For the decade leading up to 2002, an average fall cohort at ESU was 5. The respecialization program led by 2008 to a doubling of the size of the program, and by 2018 more than another doubling. This made Emporia State University's School Psychology Program as of fall 2019, with 28 admitted, one of the top five largest in the country according to an unofficial tally by NASP's Professional Development and Standards Board via Eric Rossen. ESU's program currently graduates more school psychology candidates than the other four programs in the state combined, primarily as a result of respecialization enrollment.

In 2018-19, was the lead author of the Kansas "Work Authorization" program, administered by the Kansas Association of School Psychologists in partnership with the Kansas State Department of Education. This program provides reimbursement to respecialization candidates prior to degree completion, allowing them to work in the field and earn a full professional salary, while addressing statewide shortages of school psychologists.
