¹IRS Data Retrieval Tool

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool allows applicants and their parents who have already filed their federal income tax returns to populate the answers to some questions on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by transferring data from their federal income tax returns direct from the IRS.

²Ineligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool

Most students and parents are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool if they have already filed their taxes. However, there are a few scenarios in which students and parents are ineligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, such as:

- The student/parent is married, and either the student/parent or his/her spouse filed as Married Filing Separately.
- The student/parent is married, and either the student/parent or his/her spouse filed as Head of Household.
- The parents' marital status is "Unmarried and both parents living together."
- The student/parent filed a Form 1040X amended tax return. Remember, the Form 1040X is used to correct your original tax return.
- The student/parent filed a Puerto Rican or foreign tax return.

Any student or parent ineligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool can either request their tax return transcripts from the IRS or provide a signed copy of their 2017 federal tax return. To obtain a 2017 Tax Return Transcript go to www.irs.gov and click on the "Get a tax transcript" link. You will have the option of either logging in and printing your tax return transcript immediately, or you can request the tax return transcript be mailed to the mailing address on your latest tax return. You can also request a tax return transcript by completing Form 4506T-EZ.

Amended Tax Returns

If you filed a Form 1040X amended tax return for 2017, we will need a signed copy of the Form 1040X that was filed with the IRS before verification can be completed.

Do not complete Section E if you filed a 2017 IRS Tax Return

E. Non-filer's Income Information

Will not file and not required to file a 2017 U.S. Income Tax Return based on income thresholds established by the IRS or foreign taxing authority. **If you did not file, you must** complete the section **AND** submit copies of all 2017 W-2's. **If you had no earnings enter a zero in the yearly amount field below.** All parent non-filers must also submit a Verification of Nonfiling from IRS for the 2017 tax year. A verification of nonfiling can be obtained from the IRS using Form 4506-T and checking box 7. **Each nonfiling parent must submit a separate Form 4506-T.**
