Complete both sides of this application and return it by **FEBRUARY 15**. Late applications are accepted. Priority is given to applications received before the deadline.

Preference will be given to students who include the following with their application:

- high school transcript
- brief (less than one page) statement of your career goals (word processed/typed)
- resume that outlines your academic, extracurricular, and work experience
- contact information (address, phone, and email) **for at least one and at most three references.**

Scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time during the period for which they receive a scholarship (minimum of 12 credit hours) with a major from the Department of Physical Sciences. Students will be notified of awards by letter from the University following review of applications.
