

## **Veterans “How to ESU” check list**

- **Admission** (Memorial Union, room 105) – to get acceptance to ESU
- **Financial Aid** (Plumb Hall, room 103) – contact person: Yuliana Reyes
  - Veterans or dependents wanting to use VA educational benefits
  - Pell Grant
- **Cashiers Office** (Plumb Hall, room 104) – contact person: Vicky Cooper
  - Students wanting to use Federal Tuition Assistance or State Tuition Assistance
- **Registration** (Plumb Hall, room 108) – contact person: Sheila Markowitz
  - Coordinate the transfer of military credit
  - Determine State of Kansas residency status for veterans, spouse/dependent of a veteran, current military, and spouse/dependent of a current military member.
  - Address Changes – make sure to notify the registrar office if you move.
  - Graduation – make sure to notify the registrar, so you can be recognized at the ceremony and/or obtain cords from the MU Bookstore.

- **Attention:** Prior to enrolling in courses at Emporia State University we encourage all Veterans, eligible dependents/spouses, and active duty service members to speak with their Educational Services Officer in order to discuss how their Tuition Assistance or other Veteran Educational Benefits can be applied

- **Student Wellness Center** – Counseling Services: Morse Hall Southeast, room 250
- **Student Wellness Center** – Health Services: Morse Hall Southeast, room 250. Provides students medical health care.
- **Jobs** – Handshake: online service that provides information regarding open student jobs on campus.
- **Free Legal Services for Students** – Memorial Union, Center for Student Involvement, room 150. Free legal services are available to current ESU students, Tuesdays from 1:00pm – 3:00pm during the school year. Summer hours may vary.
- **Recreation Services** – workout facilities/gym free to current ESU students.
- **Center for Early Childhood Education** – Provides daycare/preschool. Butcher Education Center, room 108.
- **IT Help Desk** – Cremer Hall, room 149, phone 620-341-5555: free IT support for ESU students.
- **Academic Center for Excellence and Success (ACES)** – William Allen White Library, room 209: provides tutoring services, academic and personal development workshops, early intervention, and student success coaching.
- **Writing Center** - William Allen White Library, room 209C
- **Center for Student Involvement** – Memorial Union, room 150. The area for all student RSO's, Associated Student Government (ASG), Fraternity & Sorority Life, Union Activities Council, Community Hornets, Corky's Cupboard, Diversity & Inclusion.
