ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR MAJORS AND MINORS

Rehabilitation & Disability Studies (RDS)

A major in rehabilitation and disability studies (44 hours) is offered under the Bachelor of Science degree. A minor option is also available comprised of 17 approved semester hours.

- A. <u>Majors and Minors:</u> Individuals wishing to major or minor in Rehabilitation & Disability Studies must meet the following conditions prior to being accepted in the program:
 - 1. Complete a minimum of 30 undergraduate credit hours, earning a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
 - 2. Complete either RE 290 Introduction to Rehabilitation Programs (3) or RE 291 Survey of Disabling Conditions (3) with a grade of B or better.
 - 3. Students with less than 2.5 cumulative grade point average may not enroll in more than six credit hours of rehabilitation course work prior to being accepted as a major or minor in the program.

After meeting the previous conditions or during the semester in which the conditions will be met, students seeking admission should do the following:

- 1. Submit a completed **Application for Admission** for the RDS Program to the RDS Program Coordinator. Include a copy of your <u>transcript</u> with the Application for Admission.
- 2. Indicate to the Student Advising Center (SAC) a desire to apply to the Rehabilitation & Disability Studies program and request that your file be forwarded to the Department of Counselor Education (Earl Center, Box 4036).
- 3. If you are admitted you will be notified, in writing, of your acceptance and you will be assigned to a faculty advisor in the RDS program at this time.
- B. Non-Major Emphasis: Non-major students desiring to take more than six (6) hours of rehabilitation course work to fulfill the emphasis requirements for other majors must meet the Rehabilitation & Disability Studies program admissions criteria of having completed a minimum of 30 undergraduate credit hours, earning a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher. The following courses will not be available for non-majors: RE 320 Special Topics in Rehabilitation; RE 699- Internship in Rehabilitation; and RE 700 Seminar in Rehabilitation...
