## 2022 Student Research Award Program

Research is important to the development of professional education. Every new piece of information has the potential for broadening perspective and improving conditions for teaching and learning. As a way of encouraging student interest in searching for new information, The Teachers College annually offers up to two awards to students at the undergraduate level and up to two awards to students at the graduate level who demonstrate an interest and competence in conducting research.

### **Eligibility**

Eligible students are those with a major in one of the departments of The Teachers College or who seek certification in a secondary teaching field.

### **Application**

Applicants may be self-nominated or nominated by another student or faculty member. An application form is attached to this announcement. The following materials along with the completed application form must be submitted electronically as a single file:

- 1. A one-paragraph abstract that briefly describes the research project to be considered for an award.
- 2. A two-page summary of the research **objectives**, **procedures**, **findings**, and **plans and implications for future research**.
- 3. A copy of the actual research report or reports. \*
- \* If the report is a thesis, a summary of no more than ten pages should be submitted.

#### **Selection Procedures**

A selection committee composed of six impartial faculty members will review applications. Committee members will establish selection criteria, although research that shows promise of stimulating additional study will be more favorably considered than those projects that use a single dimension only. Additional information may be requested from the applicants.

### **Deadline for Submission of Application**

The application and all supporting materials must be submitted as a single pdf file to Stephanie Taylor at staylo17@emporia.edu by April 1, 2022. Candidates will be notified by April 15, 2022, as to whether or not their research has been awarded special recognition by the selection committee.

#### The Award

A plaque will be presented to each award recipient at The Teachers College Honors Banquet on Friday, May 6, 2022.
