

### **Book Activity**

Materials: book or bookshelf handout, something to write/color with

#### **Directions**

- 1. Read the book aloud to the kids, make sure to ask the questions that go with each page!
- 2. Once done reading the book, hand out the printed paper(s):
  - a. Open book handout the students will either draw/write what they do in a library or they may write a story about a visit to the library.
  - b. Bookshelf handout students will write words that they think describe a library.
- 3. Once students are finished with their handout, they will share what they wrote, or drew.
