AY 2024-2025 Summary:

The Kansas State Department of Education requires a program pass-rate of 80% or higher on Praxis II content exams.

An overall pass-rate of 96.67% was observed for secondary/K-12 initial program completers who took a required exam, 82.46% was observed for undergraduate elementary initial program completers who took a required exam, and 92.06% was observed for graduate elementary initial program completers who took a required exam, each of which exceeds the minimum threshold set by the Kansas State Department of Education.
