

Measure 2: Satisfaction of Employers and Stakeholder Involvement

2025 Emporia State University/Statewide Employer Survey

The Emporia State University/Statewide Employer survey is used by several institutions in the state of Kansas and data are shared. The purpose of this survey is to obtain feedback from employers of initial program completers regarding employer perceptions of completer readiness as a result of Emporia State University's initial teacher preparation programs, as well as employer satisfaction with the completer. Questions center on 8 categories: foundations of teaching (7 items), planning (6 items), instruction (5 items), assessment (6 items), technology (6 items), motivation and engagement (6 items), professionalism and ethical behavior (5 items), and reflective practice (5 items). Item responses are based on a Likert scale: strongly agree (5), agree (4), neither agree nor disagree (3), disagree (2), and strongly disagree (1).
