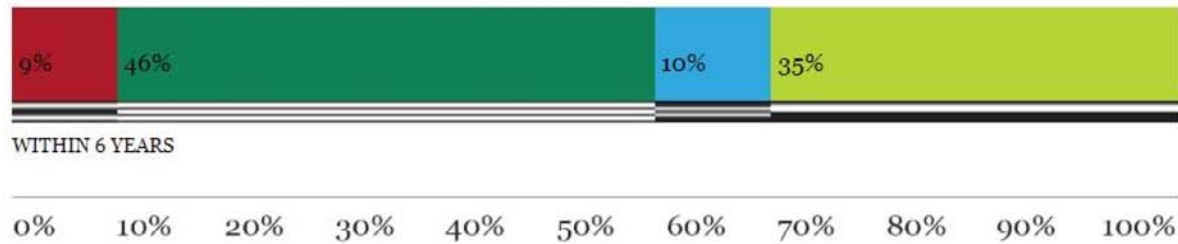

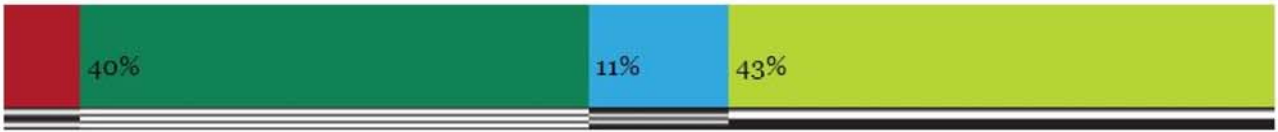

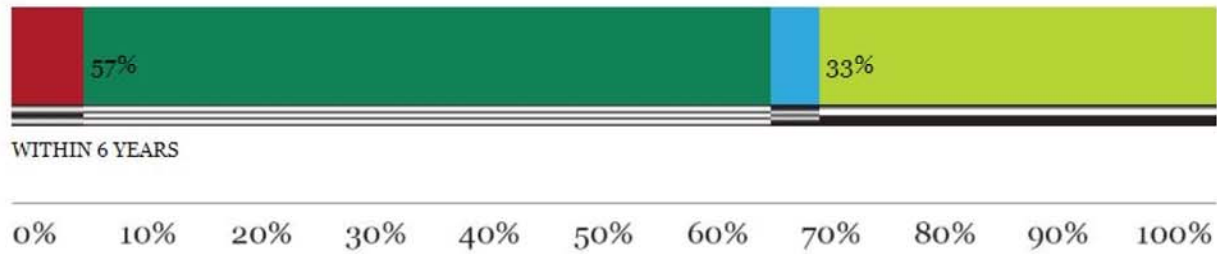


Transfer Students Starting Fall 2012
